The Book People— Marrying the Web with PDA's Creates an Efficient Sales and Distribution System

The Book People concept started in England and has now moved to the USA. Independent Distributors (The Book People) bring books into your office and let you and your coworkers review them for a week. If you want to buy copies of the titles that they brought, you fill in the provided order form and your order will be fulfilled on the day that the Distributor comes back to pick up the sample books.

A lot goes into getting those books to you. The Book People need to find your company or others that might allow them to leave books for review for a week. They need to bring titles that are likely to interest you and your coworkers. They need to have enough (but not too much) inventory; they need to leave order

forms showing the titles they brought and their prices. They need to have tools to simplify checking the orders and picking the right books to fulfill them...and more.

A web and PDA-based application built by Figtree helps the Book People and their administrators make all of these things happen successfully. The titles to be sold are dynamically printed on order forms; the PDA allows quick entry and checking of orders. The PDA information is uploaded to the web via a 'web service' to provide the information required for inventory control, commission payments, sales analysis and more.

The combination of the webbased application, the PDA application, and Web Services com-



munication allows the system to be used and maintained easily all across the Book People sales regions. Book People management pronounced the application for their new company as: 'Very Cool'.
